SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Department of Corrections for the replacement of roof hatches and a sewer pump and the repair of flooring, plumbing and a sewer grinder at various correctional centers. (BDR S-1184)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Department of Corrections for the replacement of roof hatches and a sewer pump and the repair of flooring, plumbing and a sewer grinder at various correctional centers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$49,294 for the replacement of roof hatches at the High Desert State Prison.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$80,000 for bathroom flooring and plumbing repairs at the Humboldt Conservation Camp.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$18,482 for the replacement of a sewer chopper pump at the Lovelock Correctional Center.



1 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$25,000 for the
3 repair of a sewer grinder at the Southern Desert Correctional Center.

4 **Sec. 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
5 Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$70,569 for the
6 replacement of floors and fixtures at the Tonopah Conservation
7 Camp.

8 **Sec. 6.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
9 sections 1 to 5, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for
10 expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the
11 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the
12 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and
13 any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent
14 for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to
15 which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money
16 was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the
17 State General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

18 **Sec. 7.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
