SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History for replacement of the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System and authorizes the expenditure of nonappropriated money for the same purpose. (BDR S-1192)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History for replacement of the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System; authorizing the expenditure of nonappropriated money for the same purpose; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Records, Communications and Compliance Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of \$11,500,000 for replacement of the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System.
- 2. Expenditure of \$3,955,300 not appropriated from the State General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby authorized during Fiscal Year 2019-2020 and Fiscal Year 2020-2021 by the

Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History for the same purpose as set forth in subsection 1.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
