

SENATE BILL NO. 517—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Nevada Highway Patrol for maintenance and support of the radio system, replacement of computer hardware and software, mobile data computers and portable and mobile radio equipment. (BDR S-1224)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Nevada Highway Patrol for maintenance and support of the radio system, replacement of computer hardware and software, mobile data computers and portable and mobile radio equipment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 Highway Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the
3 Department of Public Safety the sum of \$676,547 for maintenance
4 and support of the radio system.

5 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway
6 Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of
7 Public Safety the sum of \$264,871 for the replacement of computer
8 hardware and software equipment.

9 **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway
10 Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of



1 Public Safety the sum of \$1,118,772 for the replacement of mobile
2 data computers.

3 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway
4 Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of
5 Public Safety the sum of \$95,715 for portable and mobile radio
6 equipment.

7 **Sec. 5.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
8 sections 1 to 4, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for
9 expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the
10 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the
11 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and
12 any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent
13 for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to
14 which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money
15 was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the
16 State Highway Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

17 **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
