AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Distributive School Account for an unanticipated increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the State Distributive School Account the sum of
3 \$36,492,628 for an unanticipated increase in K-12 enrollment for
4 the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years. This appropriation is
5 supplemental to that made by section 3 of chapter 394, Statutes of
6 Nevada 2017, at page 2592.

7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
