AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy for an increase in the Medicaid cost-per-eligible participant and decrease in intergovernmental transfer revenue for Fiscal Years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019; authorizing the expenditure of money for the same purposes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of \$14,493,387 for an increase in the Medicaid cost-per-eligible participant and decrease in intergovernmental transfer revenue for the Fiscal Years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 20 of chapter 534, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 3672.

Sec. 2. Expenditure of \$115,587,508 not appropriated from the State General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby authorized during the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2019, and ending on June 30, 2020, by the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for the same purposes as set forth in section 1 of this act. This authorization is supplemental to that made by section 1 of chapter 397, Statutes of Nevada 2017, at page 2654.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
