- **BDR 43-1124**—Provides for a temporary special license plate to commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 468</u>.)
- **BDR 43-396**—Revises provisions regarding charitable organizations which benefit from special license plate fees. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 467</u>.)
- **BDR 18-870**—Establishes a State Marijuana Bank. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 466.)
- **BDR 58-872**—Establishes provisions relating to community solar. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 465</u>.)

- **BDR 43-395**—Provides for certain actions to be taken by DMV in certain circumstances against charitable organizations which benefit from special license plates. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 484.)
