We are here to introduce Bill Draft Requests (BDRs) 43-1124, 43-396, 18-870, and 58-872.



BDR 43-1124—Provides for a temporary special license plate to commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 468](#).)

BDR 43-396—Revises provisions regarding charitable organizations which benefit from special license plate fees. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 467](#).)

BDR 18-870—Establishes a State Marijuana Bank. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 466](#).)

BDR 58-872—Establishes provisions relating to community solar. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 465](#).)

BDR 43-1107—Revises provisions governing the regulation of electric scooters. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 485](#).)

BDR 43-395—Provides for certain actions to be taken by DMV in certain circumstances against charitable organizations which benefit from special license plates. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 484](#).)
