A.B. 189 (R1)	Expands Medicaid coverage for postpartum care and other services for pregnant women. (BDR 38-130)
A.B. 191	Requires the State Plan for Medicaid to include coverage for the services of a community health worker under certain circumstances. (BDR 38-449)
<u>A.B. 216</u> (R1)	Requires Medicaid to cover certain services for persons with cognitive impairments. (BDR 38-385)
A.B. 256 (R1)	Provides for Medicaid coverage of doula services. (BDR 38-849)
A.B. 358	Enacts provisions to improve access to Medicaid for persons released from incarceration. (BDR 38-919)
A.B. 461	Makes an appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General for the cost of replacing standard glass windows and doors with ballistic glass and frames at the Carson City office. (BDR S-1060)
A.B. 462	Makes appropriations to the Department of Corrections for an upgrade to and reintegration of certain management systems and for replacement cameras, storage area networks and ovens. (BDR S-1126)
A.B. 463	Makes a supplemental appropriation to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for an unanticipated shortfall in the Forest Fire Suppression budget account. (BDR S-1058)
