SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to off-highway vehicles.

Account for the Assistance of the Department; and
providing other matters properly relating thereto.**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 With certain exceptions, existing law requires a person who acquires ownership
 2 of an off-highway vehicle to apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for the
 3 titling and annual registration of the vehicle. (NRS 490.082) Fees paid for the
 4 titling and registration of an off-highway vehicle are required to be deposited into
 5 the Revolving Account for the Administration of Off-Highway Vehicle Titling and
 6 Registration for use by the Department to administer provisions of law relating to
 7 the titling and registration of off-highway vehicles. (NRS 490.085) Existing law
 8 also creates the Revolving Account for the Assistance of the Department and
 9 requires that all money received by the Department of Motor Vehicles from the
 10 Federal Government or any other source to assist the Department in carrying out
 11 the provisions of law relating to the titling and registration of off-highway vehicles
 12 be deposited into the Account. (NRS 490.086) This bill: (1) abolishes the
 13 Revolving Account for the Assistance of the Department; and (2) requires the State
 14 Controller to transfer any unexpended balance in the Account to the Account for
 15 Off-Highway Vehicles. Money in the Account for Off-Highway Vehicles, which is
 16 administered by the Director of the State Department of Conservation and Natural
 17 Resources, is required under existing law to be used to pay for: (1) the operating
 18 expenses of the Commission on Off-Highway Vehicles; and (2) grants for projects
 19 relating to off-highway vehicles. (NRS 490.069)



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** As soon as practicable after the effective date of
2 this act, the State Controller shall transfer any unexpended balance
3 in the Revolving Account for the Assistance of the Department
4 created by NRS 490.086 to the Account for Off-Highway Vehicles
5 created by NRS 490.069.
6 **Sec. 2.** NRS 490.086 is hereby repealed.
7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

**490.086 Revolving Account for the Assistance of the
Department: Creation; use of money in Account.**

1. The Revolving Account for the Assistance of the Department is hereby created in the State Highway Fund.
2. All money received by the Department from the Federal Government or any other source to assist the Department in carrying out the provisions of this chapter relating to the titling and registration of off-highway vehicles must be deposited into the Account.
3. Money in the Account must be used only for the purposes specified in subsection 2.
4. Any money remaining in the Account at the end of a fiscal year does not revert to the State Highway Fund, and the balance in the Account must be carried forward to the next fiscal year.
