AN ACT relating to wildfires; authorizing the State Forester Firewarden to enter into certain public-private partnerships; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law authorizes the State Forester Firewarden, with certain approval, to enter into certain cooperative agreements for the purpose of securing cooperation in forest management and the protection of the forest and watershed areas of Nevada from fire. (NRS 472.050) This bill authorizes the State Forester Firewarden, with certain approval, to also enter into certain public-private partnerships for the purpose of addressing the threat of wildfires.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 472 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The State Forester Firewarden, with the approval of the Director of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, may represent the State of Nevada in negotiating and entering into, cancelling, modifying and renewing one or more public-private partnerships for the purpose of addressing the





threat of catastrophic wildfires in this State. Any such publicprivate partnership may address, without limitation, investment in wildfire prevention, restoration, infrastructure and workforce development for enhancing landscape resiliency against the threat of wildfires.
