AN ACT **relating to state financial administration; providing for the reversion of certain money;** making a supplemental appropriation to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for an unanticipated shortfall in the Forest Fire Suppression budget account; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

During the 2019 Legislative Session, an appropriation of \$5,000,000 was made from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to provide matching money for wildfire prevention, restoration and long-term planning. (Chapter 455, Statutes of Nevada 2019, at page 2791) Section 1 of this bill provides for the reversion of any money remaining from that appropriation to the State General Fund by September 19, 2025.

Section 2 of this bill makes a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for an unanticipated shortfall in the Forest Fire Suppression budget account.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.3 of chapter 455, Statutes of Nevada 2019, at page 2791, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2.3. **1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation to the State

1 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$5,000,000
2 for wildfire prevention, restoration and long-term planning. The Interim
3 Finance Committee shall allocate money to the Department pursuant to
4 section 2.7 of this act.

5 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
6 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
7 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to
8 which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
9 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money
10 remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 19, 2025,
11 by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity
12 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must
13 be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 19,
14 2025.

15 ~~{Section 1}~~ Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General
16 Fund to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of
17 ~~{\$2,962,213}~~ \$2,359,168 for an unanticipated shortfall in the Forest Fire
18 Suppression budget account relating to directly incurred or projected costs for
19 forest fire suppression. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section
20 23 of chapter 544, Statutes of Nevada 2019, as amended by section 37 of chapter 5,
21 Statutes of Nevada 2020, 31st Special Session, at page 53.
