SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the collection of certain information by governmental agencies. (BDR 19-95)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.  
Effect on the State: Yes.

CONTAINS UNFUNDED MANDATE (§ 4)  
(NOT REQUESTED BY AFFECTED LOCAL GOVERNMENT)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets ~~omitted material~~ is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to governmental agencies; requiring ***with certain exceptions***, governmental agencies to request from certain persons information related to sexual orientation and gender identity or expression; providing, with certain exceptions, that such information is confidential; requiring a governmental agency to annually report certain information related to sexual orientation and gender identity or expression to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

Existing law authorizes certain governmental entities to collect certain personal information. (Chapter 239B of NRS) **Section 3** of this bill makes certain legislative findings and declarations related to the collection by governmental agencies of ~~demographic~~ information related to sexual orientation and gender identity or expression. “Gender identity or expression” means a gender-related identity, appearance, expression or behavior of a person, regardless of the person’s assigned sex at birth. (NRS 0.034)

**Section 2** of this bill defines “governmental agency” to include any unit of government of the State or a local government. **Section 4** of this bill: (1) requires ***with certain exceptions***, a governmental agency that ~~collects~~ ***requests*** from a person ~~demographic~~ information related to the person’s race or ethnicity to also request information related to the person’s sexual orientation and gender identity or expression; (2) provides, with limited exception, that such information is confidential; and (3) authorizes the governmental agency to use such information only for certain purposes. **Section 4** also provides that no person shall be required to provide to a governmental agency any information related to the person’s sexual orientation or gender identity or expression or denied services or assistance for failure to provide such information. **Section 4** further requires a governmental agency to submit an annual report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau that includes a summary of the information received related to sexual orientation and gender identity or expression.

**Section 5** of this bill makes a conforming change relating to the confidentiality of the information collected by a governmental agency related to sexual orientation and gender identity or expression.

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22       **Section 5.5** of this bill provides that a governmental agency that does not have the  
23 financial resources to comply with the requirements of **section 4** is not required to comply  
24 with the provisions of **section 4** until January 1, 2024. Any such governmental agency must  
25 submit an annual report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau that includes: (1)  
26 the specific reasons that the governmental agency has not complied with the requirements of  
27 **section 4**; and (2) the specific actions that the governmental agency has taken in the  
28 immediately preceding year toward compliance with the requirements of **section 4**.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** Chapter 239B of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
2 provisions set forth as sections 2, 3 and 4 of this act.

3       **Sec. 2.** *As used in sections 3 and 4 of this act, “governmental agency”*  
4 *means an officer, board, commission, department, division, bureau, district or*  
5 *any other unit of government of the State or a local government.*

6       **Sec. 3.** *The Legislature finds and declares that:*

7       1. *It is the intent of the Legislature that, in collecting ~~demographic~~*  
8 *information, governmental agencies must gather accurate information in order*  
9 *for the State and local governments to be able to enhance and improve public*  
10 *services to people in this State.*

11       2. *Various governmental agencies collect ~~demographic~~ information on*  
12 *race and ethnicity but there is limited collection by governmental agencies of*  
13 *~~demographic~~ information related to sexual orientation and gender identity or*  
14 *expression.*

15       3. *Compared to the broader community, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender*  
16 *and questioning persons experience disparities in their health and welfare and*  
17 *disproportionately high rates of poverty, suicide, homelessness, isolation,*  
18 *substance use disorders and violence. These problems are more prevalent for*  
19 *youth and seniors, communities of color and immigrants.*

20       4. *It is in the best interests of the State to respect, embrace and understand*  
21 *the full diversity of residents by collecting accurate ~~demographic~~ information to*  
22 *effectively implement and deliver critical services and programs.*

23       **Sec. 4.** 1. ~~A~~ Except as otherwise provided in this section, a  
24 governmental agency that ~~collects~~ requests from a person ~~demographic~~  
25 information related to the person’s race or ethnicity shall also request  
26 information related to the person’s sexual orientation and gender identity or  
27 expression. A peace officer is not required pursuant to this section to request  
28 from a person information related to the person’s sexual orientation and gender  
29 identity or expression when the peace officer is requesting information from a  
30 person during an interaction with the person for law enforcement purposes.

31       2. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all information related to a  
32 person’s sexual orientation or gender identity or expression that is received by a  
33 governmental agency is confidential.

34       ~~3.~~ 3. No person shall be:

35       (a) Required to provide to a governmental agency any information related to  
36 the person’s sexual orientation or gender identity or expression; or

37       (b) Denied services or assistance from a governmental agency for failure to  
38 provide to the governmental agency any information related to the person’s  
39 sexual orientation or gender identity or expression.

40       ~~4.~~ 4. A governmental agency that receives information related to a  
41 person’s sexual orientation or gender identity or expression may only use such

1 *information for carrying out the duties of the governmental agency, demographic*  
2 *analysis, coordination of care and services, improvement of care and services,*  
3 *conducting research, fulfilling a reporting requirement pursuant to federal or*  
4 *state law or informing policy or funding decisions.*

5 ~~4~~ 5. *On or before December 31 of each year, a governmental agency*  
6 *shall submit to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to*  
7 *the Legislature or, if the Legislature is not in session, to the Legislative*  
8 *Commission, a summary of the information received by the governmental agency*  
9 *related to sexual orientation or gender identity or expression, including, without*  
10 *limitation, the number of people who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual or*  
11 *transgender, according to race and gender. All information must be reported in*  
12 *the aggregate and must not include any personally identifiable information.*

13 6. *As used in this section, “peace officer” means any person upon whom*  
14 *some or all of the powers of a peace officer are conferred pursuant to NRS*  
15 *289.150 to 289.360, inclusive.*

36 such copies, abstracts or memoranda may be used to supply the general public with  
37 copies, abstracts or memoranda of the records or may be used in any other way to  
38 the advantage of the governmental entity or of the general public. This section does  
39 not supersede or in any manner affect the federal laws governing copyrights or  
40 enlarge, diminish or affect in any other manner the rights of a person in any written  
41 book or record which is copyrighted pursuant to federal law.

42 2. A governmental entity may not reject a book or record which is  
43 copyrighted solely because it is copyrighted.

44 3. A governmental entity that has legal custody or control of a public book or  
45 record shall not deny a request made pursuant to subsection 1 to inspect or copy or  
46 receive a copy of a public book or record on the basis that the requested public  
47 book or record contains information that is confidential if the governmental entity  
48 can redact, delete, conceal or separate, including, without limitation, electronically,  
49 the confidential information from the information included in the public book or  
50 record that is not otherwise confidential.

51 4. If requested, a governmental entity shall provide a copy of a public record  
52 in an electronic format by means of an electronic medium. Nothing in this

1 subsection requires a governmental entity to provide a copy of a public record in an  
2 electronic format or by means of an electronic medium if:

3 (a) The public record:

4 (1) Was not created or prepared in an electronic format; and

5 (2) Is not available in an electronic format; or

6 (b) Providing the public record in an electronic format or by means of an  
7 electronic medium would:

8 (1) Give access to proprietary software; or

9 (2) Require the production of information that is confidential and that  
10 cannot be redacted, deleted, concealed or separated from information that is not  
11 otherwise confidential.

12 5. An officer, employee or agent of a governmental entity who has legal  
13 custody or control of a public record:

14 (a) Shall not refuse to provide a copy of that public record in the medium that  
15 is requested because the officer, employee or agent has already prepared or would  
16 prefer to provide the copy in a different medium.

17 (b) Except as otherwise provided in NRS 239.030, shall, upon request, prepare  
18 the copy of the public record and shall not require the person who has requested the  
19 copy to prepare the copy himself or herself.

20 **Sec. 5.5.** 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4 of this act, if a  
21 governmental agency does not have sufficient financial resources to comply with  
22 the provisions of section 4 of this act, the governmental agency is not required to  
23 comply with the provisions of section 4 of this act until January 1, 2024. Any such  
24 governmental agency must, on or before January 1 of each year, starting on January  
25 1, 2022, submit to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to  
26 the Legislature or, if the Legislature is not in session, to the Legislative  
27 Commission, a report which indicates:

28 (a) The specific reasons that the governmental agency has not complied with  
29 the requirements of section 4 of this act; and

30 (b) The specific actions that the governmental agency has taken in the  
31 immediately preceding year toward compliance with the requirements of section 4  
32 of this act.

33 2. As used in this section, "governmental agency" has the meaning ascribed to  
34 it in section 2 of this act.

35 **Sec. 6.** The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 218D.380 do not apply to any  
36 provision of this act which adds or revises a requirement to submit a report to the  
37 Legislature.

38 **Sec. 7.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional  
39 expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.
