SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to charter schools. (BDR 34-530)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the governing body of each charter school that enters into a contract with certain organizations to report certain information to the State Public Charter School Authority in each even-numbered year; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

#### **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, a charter school is authorized to contract with educational management organizations to provide services relating to the operation and management of the school. (NRS 388A.030; 388A.223) This bill requires the governing body of each charter school that enters into a contract with an educational management organization to submit a report in each even-numbered year to the State Public Charter School Authority that includes the amount paid to the management company under the contract.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 388A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

On or before November 1 of each even-numbered year, the governing body of each charter school that enters into a contract with an educational management organization shall submit to the
