SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to charter schools.
(BDR 34-530)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the governing body of each charter school that enters into a contract with certain organizations to report certain information to the State Public Charter School Authority in each even-numbered year; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Under existing law, a charter school is authorized to contract with educational
2 management organizations to provide services relating to the operation and
3 management of the school. (NRS 388A.030; 388A.223) This bill requires the
4 governing body of each charter school that enters into a contract with an
5 educational management organization to submit a report in each even-numbered
6 year to the State Public Charter School Authority that includes the amount paid to
7 the management company under the contract.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 388A of NRS is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *On or before November 1 of each even-numbered year, the*
4 *governing body of each charter school that enters into a contract*
5 *with an educational management organization shall submit to the*



- 1 *State Public Charter School Authority a report that includes the*
- 2 *amount paid to the educational management organization in the*
- 3 *current and immediately preceding fiscal years.*
