AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Distributive School Account for an unanticipated decrease in revenues for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the State Distributive School Account created by NRS
- 3 387.030 the sum of \$268,433,822 for an unanticipated decrease in
- 4 revenues for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years. This
- 5 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 5 of chapter
- 6 376, Statutes of Nevada 2019, as amended by section 65 of chapter
- 7 5, Statutes of Nevada 2020, 31st Special Session, at page 64.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
