SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to state financial administration. (BDR S-1176)

AN ACT relating to state financial administration; making appropriations to certain state agencies for certain purposes; revising provisions relating to the compensation of employees of the Senate and Assembly; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human Services for the Northern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services budget account the sum of \$389,399 for community-based living arrangement services.

2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2022, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 16, 2022, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 16, 2022.

Sec. 2. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the

25 2. In addition to the positions listed in subsection 1, the
26 Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the Assembly may
27 establish additional positions as necessary and shall establish an
28 appropriate base amount for those additional positions.

29 3. The base amount paid to an employee of the Legislature
30 listed in subsection 1 or created pursuant to subsection 2:

31 (a) Must be increased cumulatively by each cost of living
32 increase granted to employees in the classified service of the State
33 that becomes effective on or after July 1, 2001; and

34 (b) May be increased cumulatively by the Secretary of the
35 Senate or the Chief Clerk of the Assembly, as applicable, by:

36 (1) One step of 5 percent for each regular session during
37 which the employee previously worked for the Legislature in the
38 same or a similar position, not to exceed the number of steps in
39 the State's compensation schedule per position, if the Secretary of
40 the Senate or the Chief Clerk of the Assembly determined that the
41 employee performed his or her duties in a satisfactory manner
42 during the previous regular session or sessions; or

43 (2) One or more steps of 5 percent, not to exceed the number
44 of steps in the State's compensation schedule per position, as
45 determined by the Secretary of the Senate or the Chief Clerk of the



1 Assembly, based upon previous service with the Legislative Counsel
2 Bureau in a position that is similar to the position with the Senate or
3 the Assembly, as applicable.

4 4. If an employee of the Legislative Counsel Bureau transfers
5 to a position with the Senate or the Assembly during a regular or
6 special session, the employee may, with the approval of the
7 Secretary of the Senate or the Chief Clerk of the Assembly, continue
8 to be paid on an hourly basis at the same rate that the employee was
9 being paid by the Legislative Counsel Bureau if the position with
10 the Legislative Counsel Bureau is similar to the position with the
11 Senate or the Assembly, as applicable.

12 5. During periods of adjournment to a day certain, employees
13 of the Legislature whose service is required shall perform duties as
14 assigned and are entitled to be paid the amount specified in
15 subsection 1 for each day of service, as adjusted pursuant to
16 subsection 3, if applicable.

17 6. During periods before the commencement of a regular or
18 special session and after the adjournment of a regular or special
19 session sine die, employees of the Legislature whose service is
20 required shall perform duties as assigned and are entitled to be paid
21 at an hourly rate commensurate with the daily rate specified in
22 subsection 1, as applicable, and are entitled to be compensated for
23 overtime in the same manner as provided for employees of the
24 Legislative Counsel Bureau.

25 *7. During a special session and with the approval of the*
26 *Secretary of the Senate or the Chief Clerk of the Assembly, an*
27 *employee of the Legislature whose service is required may be paid*
28 *at an hourly rate commensurate with the daily rate specified in*
29 *subsection 1, as applicable, and compensated for overtime in the*
30 *same manner as provided for employees of the Legislative Counsel*
31 *Bureau.*

32 **Sec. 18.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021.
