SENATOR SEEVERS GANSERT:

There is another piece of legislation contemplating how much time after the election the ballots can be received. I want to make sure they all match up as far as the time frame after the election when we can receive ballots postmarked on the day of the election.

SENATOR SETTELMEYER:

The indication is that laws are being changed at the federal level. If they change laws, the State of Nevada will have to adjust its laws in that respect.

CHAIR OHRENSCHALL:

The Legislative Counsel Bureau looks to harmonize all bills when they focus on different areas of the *Nevada Revised Statutes*.

MARK WLASCHIN (Deputy of Elections, Office of the Secretary of State): Senator Seevers Gansert is correct on the shifting timelines, but we have nothing further with that regard.

JOE GLORIA (Registrar of Voters, Clark County):

We are willing to work with Senator Settelmeyer and the Committee to make this bill work. We want to include and give as much opportunity as we can to overseas voters. We can continue to work on this bill, but I would recommend we move forward with the current language and make adjustments as necessary.
