SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing drivers' licenses. (BDR 43-635)

EXPLANATION - Matter in bolded italics is new; matter between brackets fomitted material; is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to drivers' licenses; requiring, under certain circumstances, that the Department of Motor Vehicles place a designation on a driver's license for certain persons with autism; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles to adopt regulations establishing a program for the imprinting of a symbol or other indicator of a medical condition on a driver's license. (NRS 483.3485) Existing law further requires, upon the application of a person with a disability which limits or impairs the ability to walk, that the Department place a designation on any driver's license issued to the person indicating that the person is a person with such disability. (NRS 483.349) **Section 1** of this bill requires, upon the application of a person with autism, that the Department place on any driver's license issued to the person a designation indicating that the person is a person with autism. The application must include a statement from a licensed physician or an advanced practice registered nurse certifying that the applicant is a person with autism.

Sections 2 and 3 of this bill make conforming changes to indicate the proper placement of section 1 in the Nevada Revised Statutes.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 483 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Upon the application of a person with autism, the Department shall place on any driver's license issued to the person pursuant to

the provisions of this chapter a designation that the person is a person with autism. The application must include a statement from a licensed physician or an advanced practice registered nurse certifying that the applicant is a person with autism.

**Sec. 2.** NRS 483.015 is hereby amended to read as follows: 483.015 Except as otherwise provided in NRS 483.330, the provisions of NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, *and section 1 of* 

this act apply only with respect to noncommercial drivers' licenses. Sec. 3. NRS 483.020 is hereby amended to read as follows: 483.020 As used in NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, and

section 1 of this act, unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in NRS 483.030 to 483.190, inclusive, have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

**Sec. 4.** 1. This section becomes effective upon passage and approval.

2. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act become effective:

- (a) Upon passage and approval for the purpose of adopting any regulations and performing any other preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; and
  - (b) On January 1, 2024, for all other purposes.
