**AN ACT** making appropriations to the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor as loans for the replacement of an information technology service management provider and computer hardware and associated software; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor  
3 the sum of \$299,974 as a loan to the Enterprise Application Services  
4 Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services  
5 of the Department of Administration for the replacement of the  
6 information technology service management provider.  
7     2. Commencing on July 1, 2025, the Enterprise Application  
8 Services Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology  
9 Services of the Department of Administration shall use revenues  
10 from the intergovernmental transfers to repay in annual installments  
11 the cost of the replacement of the information technology service

1 management provider to the State Treasurer for deposit in the State  
2 General Fund. Each annual installment must be 25 percent of the  
3 cost of the replacement of the information technology service  
4 management provider and the loan must be fully repaid not later  
5 than the end of Fiscal Year 2028-2029.

6 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
7 General Fund to the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor  
8 the sum of \$122,958 as a loan to the Enterprise Application Services  
9 Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services  
10 of the Department of Administration for the replacement of  
11 computer hardware and associated software.

12 2. Commencing on July 1, 2025, the Enterprise Application  
13 Services Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology  
14 Services of the Department of Administration shall use revenues  
15 from the intergovernmental transfers to repay in annual installments  
16 the cost of the replacement of computer hardware and associated  
17 software to the State Treasurer for deposit in the State General  
18 Fund. Each annual installment must be 25 percent of the cost of the  
19 replacement of computer hardware and associated software and the  
20 loan must be fully repaid not later than the end of Fiscal Year  
21 2028-2029.

22 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by  
23 sections 1 and 2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure  
24 after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made  
25 or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or  
26 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
27 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
28 after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money  
29 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
30 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
31 Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

32 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
