SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Office of ~~Information Security of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration~~ Finance in the Office of the Governor as a loan for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software. (BDR S-1129)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Office of ~~Information Security of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration~~ Finance in the Office of the Governor as a loan for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
2 the Office of ~~Information Security of the Division of Enterprise Information~~
3 ~~Technology Services of the Department of Administration~~ Finance in the Office
4 of the Governor the sum of \$17,147 as a loan to the Division of Enterprise
5 Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration for the
6 replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

7 2. Commencing on July 1, 2025, the Division of Enterprise Information
8 Technology Services of the Department of Administration shall use revenues
9 from intergovernmental transfers to repay in annual installments the cost of
10 the replacement of computer hardware and associated software to the State
11 Treasurer for deposit in the State General Fund. Each annual installment
12 must be 25 percent of the cost of the replacement of the computer hardware
13 and associated software and the loan must be fully repaid not later than the
14 end of Fiscal Year 2028-2029.

1 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not
2 be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the
3 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is
4 granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
5 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 19, 2025, by
6 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the
7 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State
8 General Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

9 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
