SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety for the replacement or purchase of vehicles, motorcycles, weapons and certain equipment and a staffing study. (BDR S-1163)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety for the replacement or purchase of vehicles, motorcycles, weapons and certain equipment and a staffing study; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
2 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
3 \$11,948,770 for the replacement of fleet vehicles and associated special equipment.

4 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
5 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
6 \$275,859 for the replacement of fleet motorcycles and associated special
7 equipment.

8 **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
9 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
10 ~~[\$66,620]~~ **\$77,120** for the replacement of vehicle hoists, tire changing machines
11 and a forklift.

12 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
13 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
14 \$987,548 for the replacement of ballistic rifle vests, helmets, patrol rifles and red
15 dot sights.

1 **Sec. 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
2 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
3 \$702,720 for the replacement of taser weapons.

4 **Sec. 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
5 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
6 \$438,385 for the replacement of mobile data computers.

7 **Sec. 7.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
8 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
9 \$43,370 for the replacement of radar certification systems.

10 **Sec. 8.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
11 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
12 \$1,783,667 for the replacement of portable event recording devices and associated
13 software.

14 **Sec. 9.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
15 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
16 \$39,990 for the replacement of equipment for weighing vehicles.

17 **Sec. 10.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
18 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
19 \$422,122 for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

20 **Sec. 11.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
21 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
22 \$13,004 for the purchase of oil filter crushers and a steel shipping container for use
23 as a fabrication workspace.

24 **Sec. 12.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
25 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
26 \$415,525 for the purchase of oral fluid mobile testing devices and cartridges.

27 **Sec. 13.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
28 Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
29 ~~[\$50,000]~~ **\$74,889** for a staffing study of the Division.

30 **Sec. 14.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by sections 1 to
31 13, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2025,
32 by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from
33 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion
34 of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
35 September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or
36 the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
37 reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

38 **Sec. 15.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
