SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to governmental administration. (BDR 27-876)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.

AN ACT relating to governmental administration; requiring a state agency or local government to post certain information on its Internet website relating to certain purchasing contracts, performance contracts and contracts for public works; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law authorizes, under certain circumstances, a state agency or local government to enter into certain purchasing contracts, performance contracts and contracts for public works. (Chapters 332, 333, 333A and 338 of NRS) Sections 1-4 of this bill require each state agency or local government to, on or before September 1 of each year, post in a conspicuous place on its Internet website: (1) the total number of such contracts awarded by the state agency or local government during the immediately preceding fiscal year; (2) the total dollar amount of all such contracts awarded by the state agency or local government during the immediately preceding fiscal year to minority-owned businesses, women-owned businesses, fand! LGBTQ-owned businesses; and (4) the total dollar amount of all such contracts awarded by the state agency or local government during the immediately preceding fiscal year to minority-owned businesses; and (4) the total dollar amount of all such contracts awarded by the state agency or local government during the immediately preceding fiscal year to minority-owned businesses, women-owned businesses, [and] LGBTQ-owned businesses [1] and veteranowned businesses.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:
