SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural Affairs for the replacement and purchase of computer hardware, software and related services, office furniture, equipment and vehicles and for deferred maintenance projects. (BDR S-1132)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural Affairs for the replacement and purchase of computer hardware, software and related services, office furniture, equipment and vehicles and for deferred maintenance projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
2 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
3 Affairs the sum of \$5,040 for the Museums and History Administration budget
4 account for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

5 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
6 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
7 Affairs the sum of \$6,164 for the Museums and History Administration budget
8 account for the costs of computer subscription services.

9 **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
10 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
11 Affairs the sum of \$9,825 for the Lost City Museum budget account for the
12 replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

13 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
14 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural

1 Affairs the sum of \$19,400 for the Lost City Museum budget account for deferred
2 maintenance projects.

3 **Sec. 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
4 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
5 Affairs the sum of ~~[\$27,418]~~ **\$57,485** for the Lost City Museum budget account for
6 the replacement of a vehicle.

7 **Sec. 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
8 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
9 Affairs the sum of \$7,158 for the Nevada Historical Society budget account for the
10 replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

11 **Sec. 7.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
12 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
13 Affairs the sum of \$5,074 for the Nevada Historical Society budget account for the
14 purchase of office furniture.

15 **Sec. 8.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
16 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
17 Affairs the sum of \$54,190 for the Nevada Historical Society budget account for
18 deferred maintenance projects.

19 **Sec. 9.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
20 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
21 Affairs the sum of \$11,139 for the Nevada State Museum, Carson City, budget
22 account for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

23 **Sec. 10.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
24 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
25 Affairs the sum of \$5,250 for the Nevada State Museum, Carson City, budget
26 account for the costs of a building surge protection system.

27 **Sec. 11.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
28 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
29 Affairs the sum of \$68,000 for the Nevada State Museum, Carson City, budget
30 account for the costs of updating the online plant collection database.

31 **Sec. 12.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
32 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
33 Affairs the sum of \$6,354 for the Nevada State Museum, Las Vegas, budget
34 account for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

35 **Sec. 13.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
36 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
37 Affairs the sum of ~~[\$39,170]~~ **\$57,485** for the Nevada State Museum, Las Vegas,
38 budget account for the replacement of a vehicle.

39 **Sec. 14.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
40 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
41 Affairs the sum of \$68,825 for the Nevada State Museum, Las Vegas, budget
42 account for deferred maintenance projects.

43 **Sec. 15.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
44 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
45 Affairs the sum of \$24,651 for the Nevada State Railroad Museums budget account
46 for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software.

47 **Sec. 16.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
48 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
49 Affairs the sum of ~~[\$156,072]~~ **\$185,743** for the Nevada State Railroad Museums
50 budget account for the replacement of vehicles.

51 **Sec. 17.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
52 Division of Museums and History of the Department of Tourism and Cultural

1 Affairs the sum of ~~[\$342,372]~~ \$594,999 for the Nevada State Railroad Museums
2 budget account for deferred maintenance projects.

3 **Sec. 18.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by sections 1 to
4 17, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2025,
5 by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from
6 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion
7 of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
8 September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or
9 the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
10 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

11 **Sec. 19.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
