Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Veterans Services to provide financial assistance and support for the Adopt a Vet Dental Program in Southern Nevada the following sums:

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Veterans Services to provide financial assistance and support for the Adopt a Vet Dental Program in Northern Nevada the following sums:

For the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 \$250,000 For the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 \$250,000

Sec. 3. Any balance of the sums appropriated by sections 1 and 2 of this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years

must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 20, 2024, and September 19, 2025, respectively, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 20, 2024, and September 19, 2025, respectively.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2023.
