AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Veterans  
Services to provide financial assistance and support for  
the Adopt a Vet Dental Program; and providing other  
matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
Fund to the Department of Veterans Services to provide financial  
assistance and support for the Adopt a Vet Dental Program in  
Southern Nevada the following sums:

For the Fiscal Year 2023-2024.....	\$250,000
For the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 .....	\$250,000

**Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
Fund to the Department of Veterans Services to provide financial  
assistance and support for the Adopt a Vet Dental Program in  
Northern Nevada the following sums:

For the Fiscal Year 2023-2024.....	\$250,000
For the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 .....	\$250,000

**Sec. 3.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by sections 1  
and 2 of this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years



1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the  
2 respective fiscal years by the entity to which the appropriation is  
3 made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is  
4 granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of  
5 the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any  
6 purpose after September 20, 2024, and September 19, 2025,  
7 respectively, by either the entity to which the money was  
8 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
9 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
10 Fund on or before September 20, 2024, and September 19, 2025,  
11 respectively.

12 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2023.
