Chair Monroe-Moreno:

[Roll was called, and the Committee's rules and protocols were explained.] We only have one item on our agenda for today, and that is a work session for <u>Assembly Bill 464</u>. With that, I will turn it over to our Fiscal Analyst.

Assembly Bill 464: Makes an appropriation to the Legislative Fund for costs relating to anticipated building renovations. (BDR S-1107)

Sarah Coffman, Assembly Fiscal Analyst:

Assembly Bill 464 makes a State General Fund appropriation of \$1,050,000 to the Legislative Fund for the costs of advanced planning documents relating to anticipated building renovations. I would note that there is a proposed amendment, which should be on your desks [Exhibit C]. It is Proposed Amendment 3605 to Assembly Bill 464. The amendment provides an additional \$500,000 for preparation work, planning, and inspection, in addition to the work on the western security entrance of the Legislative Counsel Bureau Building. With that, I would be happy to answer any questions.

Chair Monroe-Moreno:

Members, are there any questions on the bill or the amendment? We heard this bill last week. Hearing no questions, I will entertain a motion to amend and do pass.

ASSEMBLYWOMAN JAUREGUI MOVED TO AMEND AND DO PASS ASSEMBLY BILL 464.

ASSEMBLYWOMAN BACKUS SECONDED THE MOTION.

Assemblyman O'Neill:

I will vote for the bill to get it out of the Committee, but I want to reserve my right to change my vote on the floor. I want to look at yesterday's Economic Forum matters. My biggest concern is we are going to invest this money, but will we have the money later to do the work? Unfortunately, we have lacked the funds in the past for other projects in the state. That is my initial concern that I wanted to voice to you. I will vote yes in the Committee, but I will reserve my right to change my vote on the floor.

Chair Monroe-Moreno:

Is there any other discussion? [There was none.]

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I will present the floor statement myself. That brings us to the last item on our agenda, which is public comment. I will open public comment. [There was none.]
