Sarah Coffman, Assembly Fiscal Analyst:

[Ms. Coffman presented the following bill draft requests:]

- **BDR S-1112**—Makes appropriations to the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor for the replacement of furniture and certain equipment. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 489.)
- **BDR S-1128**—Makes appropriations to the Communication and Computing Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software, the replacement of components of a security firewall and security upgrades to mountaintop microwave sites. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 488.</u>)
- **BDR S-1129**—Makes an appropriation to the Office of Information Security of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 487.)
- **BDR S-1130**—Makes appropriations to the Division of State Library, Archives and Public Records of the Department of Administration for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software and the purchase of digitization equipment and technology. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 486.</u>)
- **BDR S-1141**—Makes an appropriation to the Legislative Fund for capital improvement projects for facilities and information technology services projects. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 485</u>.)
- **BDR S-1144**—Makes an appropriation to the Office of Economic Development in the Office of the Governor for the support of designated regional development authorities. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 484</u>.)
- **BDR S-1145** —Makes an appropriation to the Workforce Innovations for a New Nevada Account. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 483.)

- **BDR S-1146**—Makes appropriations to the Enterprise Application Services Unit of the Division of Enterprise Information Technology Services of the Department of Administration for the replacement of an information technology service management provider and computer hardware and associated software. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 482.)
- **BDR S-1149**—Makes an appropriation to the Account for the Nevada Main Street Program. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 481</u>.)
- **BDR S-1155**—Makes an appropriation to the Interim Finance Committee to allocate to certain state agencies to implement language access plans. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 480.)
- **BDR S-1158**—Makes appropriations to the State Board of Parole Commissioners for the replacement of computer hardware, software and related equipment and licenses to upgrade a computer operating system. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 479.</u>)
- **BDR S-1166**—Makes an appropriation to the State Emergency Response Commission for the replacement of computer hardware and associated software. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 478.</u>)
- **BDR S-1168**—Makes appropriations to and authorizes the expenditure of money by the Department of Transportation for the replacement of the Nevada Shared Radio System. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 477.</u>)
- **BDR S-1182**—Makes appropriations to and authorizes the expenditure of money by the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services for the replacement or purchase of computer hardware and associated software and door locks. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 476</u>.)
