Comment: The bill, as proposed, may result in an increase in detention bed days for youth in custody committed to the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) if their admissions teams deny placements to correctional or behavioral health facilities. Youth awaiting placement at DCFS facilities already experience significantly longer lengths of stay in Juvenile Detention, which in turn affects staffing levels and increases operational costs. However, it is not possible to determine the future costs associated with these potential changes at this time.
